The « Student Member » Status is free of charge, personal and not transferrable. (There is no age requirement and no limite in duration)

Are eligible:

- Students undertaking a <u>full time tertiary education at a nationally recognized Educational Body</u> (College, University, Training Establishment)
- M.Sc. Students, PhD. Students and D.Sc. Students.

Members Students are selected by the National Committee of CIGRE which at the beginning of each Academic year, must require a Certificate of Education to ensure the renewal of the status of the Student Member. Otherwise, the rights related to the status are stopped.
